Fashion Show 2016-Guidelines

By signing these guidelines, the student and parent acknowledges and agrees to the following:

1-Students who are absent from school for two or more blocks in a given day may not attend rehearsal or participate in the Fashion Show on that day. This is a CMS policy. Please make every effort to be in school on rehearsal and Fashion Show dates as participating is the major component of grades for this quarter.

2-The student will be serious and focused during rehearsals and during the show itself.

3-Cell phones will be OFF during rehearsals and the Fashion Show.

4-Students will refrain from bringing food or drinks other than water into the Black Box. Eating will be allowed in designated areas only, away from all Fashion Show garments. Students must wash hands after eating as to avoid any stains or greasy mishaps before the show.

5-The student agrees to be supportive of his/her fellow classmates and models; to create a safe and sensitive environment in which students can rehearse and take risks; and to avoid negative comments and actions during preparation, rehearsals, outside of rehearsals, and on social media.

6-Students acknowledge that they are representatives of Northwest School of the Arts. They will adhere to the highest possible standards in etiquette and as ambassadors for NWSA throughout the Fashion Show process.

7-All necessary forms must be completed and turned in by designated times as outlined in the (attached) rubric. Models must have approval forms turned in by the deadlines as well.

8-Rehearsals are as follows:

- Meeting/Rehearsal-Wednesday, May 11th from 4:30pm-7:00pm
- Dress Rehearsal-Thursday, May 12th from 4:30pm-7:30pm

9-Students will be assigned rooms to get ready in during dress rehearsal and for the Fashion Show. Students will respect their room assignments and see Mrs. Kelvington if a change needs to be made. Students are responsible for leaving the rooms clean and taking all belongings home after the dress rehearsal/Fashion Show.

10-All garments to be modeled in the Fashion Show must be turned in and left with Mrs. Kelvington on May 9th (A)/10th (B) until the dress rehearsal. Garments must be completely finished, pressed/ironed/steamed on a hanger. Any garment turned in after these days will not be allowed in the fashion show. Garments must be appropriate and approved by Mrs. Kelvington in order to be modeled in the show. A photo of all garments must be submitted by this time as well (on a model, not just a dress form—this does not have to be fancy). Email photos to: **NWSAFashion@gmail.com**

11-Music selections for students with 5 or more looks must be turned in by May 9th(A)/10th (B) for approval.

12-Students will receive one formal grade for pre-show requirements, one for attending the rehearsals, and one for the Fashion Show itself as outlined on the rubric.

13-The show order will run as follows on **Friday, May 13th at 7:00pm in the Black Box:**

- (Visual Arts Students) Jewelry modeled by faculty
- Costumes
- Apparel I garments
- Apparel II garments
- Mini Collections (3+ looks/outfits)
- Collections (5+ looks/outfits, students may choose own music)

14- Students who wish to eat dinner at school before the Fashion Show on Friday must bring \$5 in cash or check made payable to: Theatre Arts Guild/T.A.G. by **May 5th(A)/6th (B)**. Otherwise, they must pack a dinner and bring it to school that day or have it dropped off for them between 4:15pm and 5:30pm.
