Flat-Felled Seam



A flat-felled seam is self-enclosed and requires no additional seam finishing technique. Use it where durability is needed or a tailored appearance is desired.

Follow these steps:

1. With the wrong sides of the fabric together, make a plain seam. Press seam allowances in one direction.
2. Trim the under seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.
3. On the remaining seam allowance, turn under $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and press. Fold this side over the trimmed edge. Pin in place.
4. Stitch very close to the folded edge of the seam allowance.
