Reinforced Seam

The reinforced seam is used in areas that receive more stress while the garment is worn. The crotch seam on pants is an example of a seam that would be reinforced.

1. Pin the edges of the two 8" sides together. Be sure they are even and there are enough pins to hold the edges in place.
2. Use a reinforcement stitch of 15 to 20 stitches per inch (Set your machine to 1 or 1.5 for stitch length)
3. Follow steps 3-10 on the plain seam to complete the reinforced seam.
