### Serged Seam Finish-I

The serged seam can be used on a variety of garments. It is suitable for woven fabrics, but it can be used with knits too because the seam will stretch. Because the seam allowance will be cut off after the seam is sewn, you must be sure of the fit before you stitch.

Follow these steps:

1. Pin right sides together with the two 8" sides together. Be sure there are enough pins to hold the edges in place.
2. Stitch one line of stitching at the 5/8" mark. Be sure to backstitch at the beginning and end.
3. Serge the edge lining it up with the edge of the throat plate on the serger.
